**RESCISSION OF ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER
OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS FOR THE CONTROL OF COVID-19
PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY QUARANTINE ORDER
DATE OF RESCISSION: December 28, 2021**

Effective immediately, the COVID-19 Quarantine Health Officer Order issued April 7, 2020, and last amended September 22, 2021, is rescinded.

Transmission rates of COVID-19 remain high in Stanislaus County and the risk of COVID-19 variants including Omicron are still largely unknown. Accordingly, individuals should continue to follow guidance released by the United States Department of Health & Human Services including their sub-agency the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the California Department of Public Health, and California Department of Social Services. The Order is rescinded in order to align with the above-mentioned authorities and guidelines.

Staying home and away from others and getting tested after being exposed to someone with COVID-19 is extremely important for stopping spread and rescission of this order should not be taken to indicate otherwise.

The Stanislaus County Health Officer will continue to assess the public health situation as it continues to evolve and may re-issue the Quarantine Order as changing circumstances dictate.
