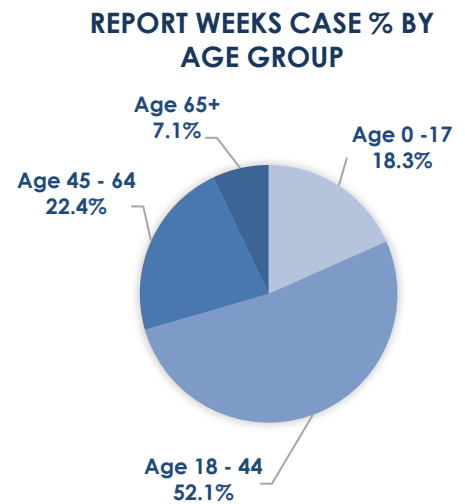

- All indicators are showing increases in COVID-19 activity in this two-week period.

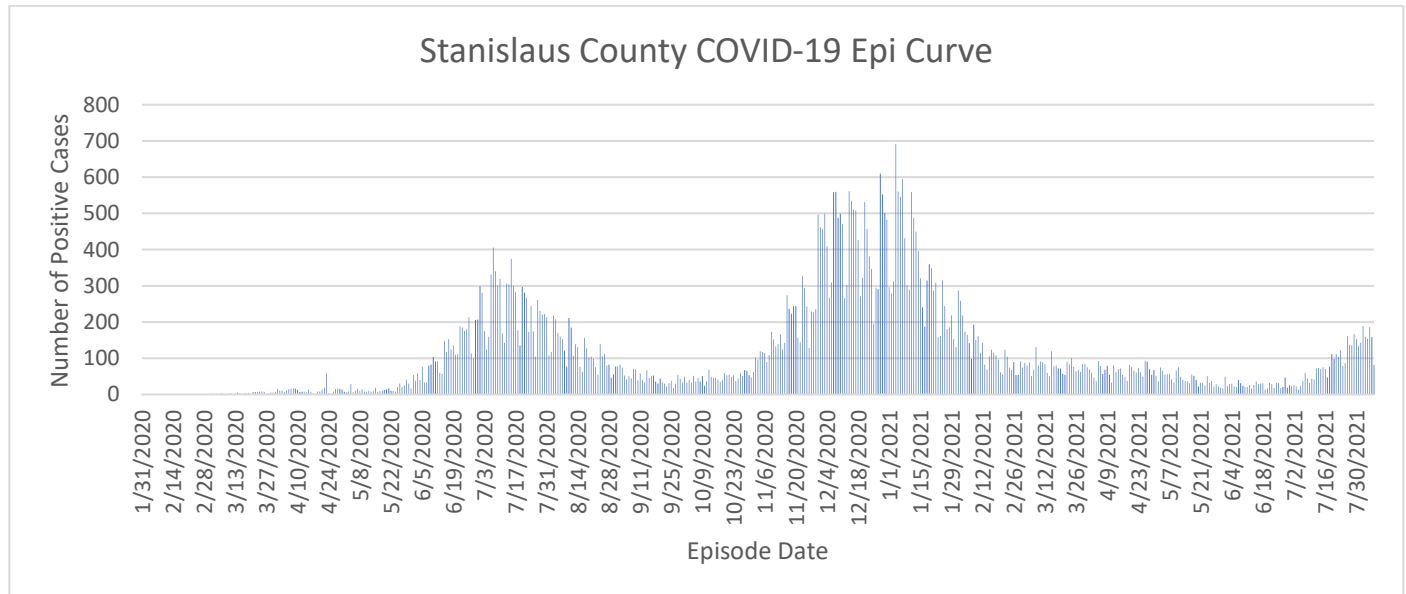

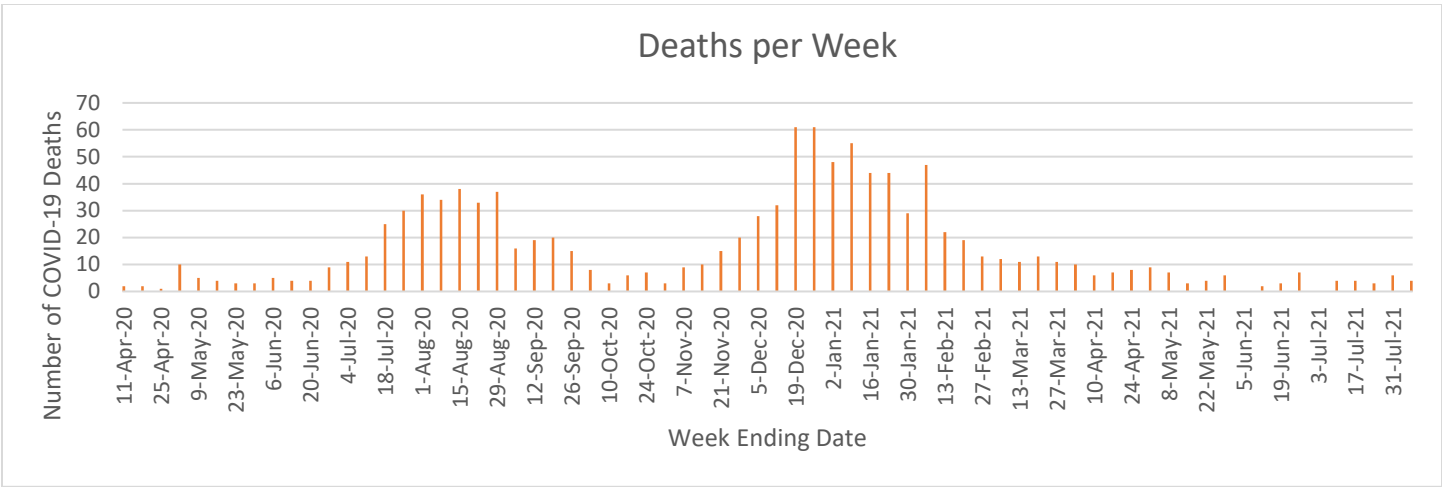

The episode date is the earliest date a person is known to have the virus and is determined using a few variables including symptom onset date and the date they were tested.



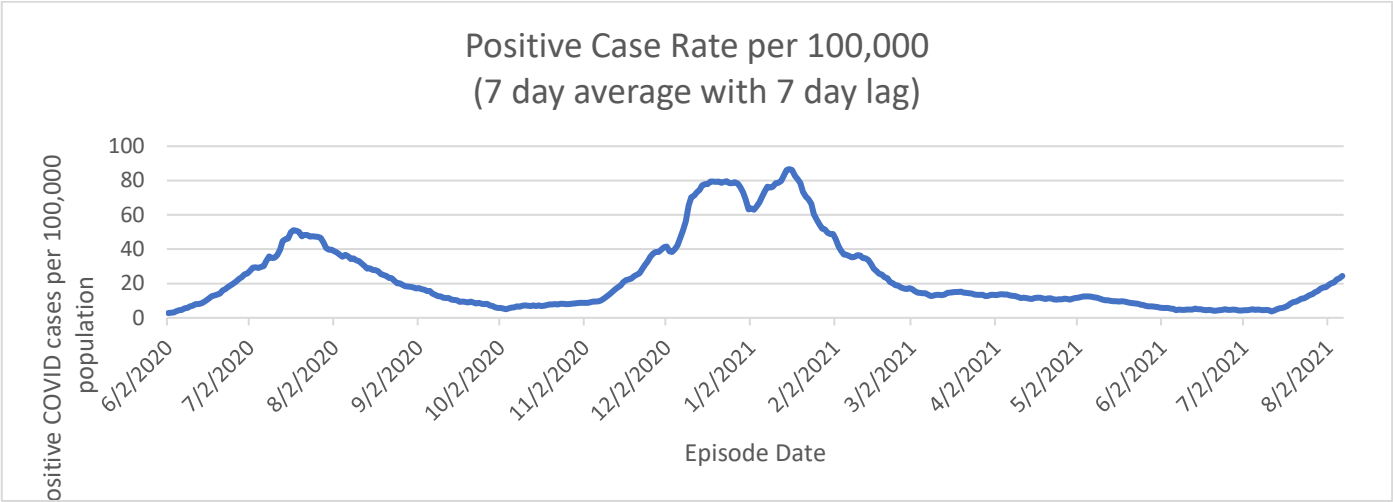

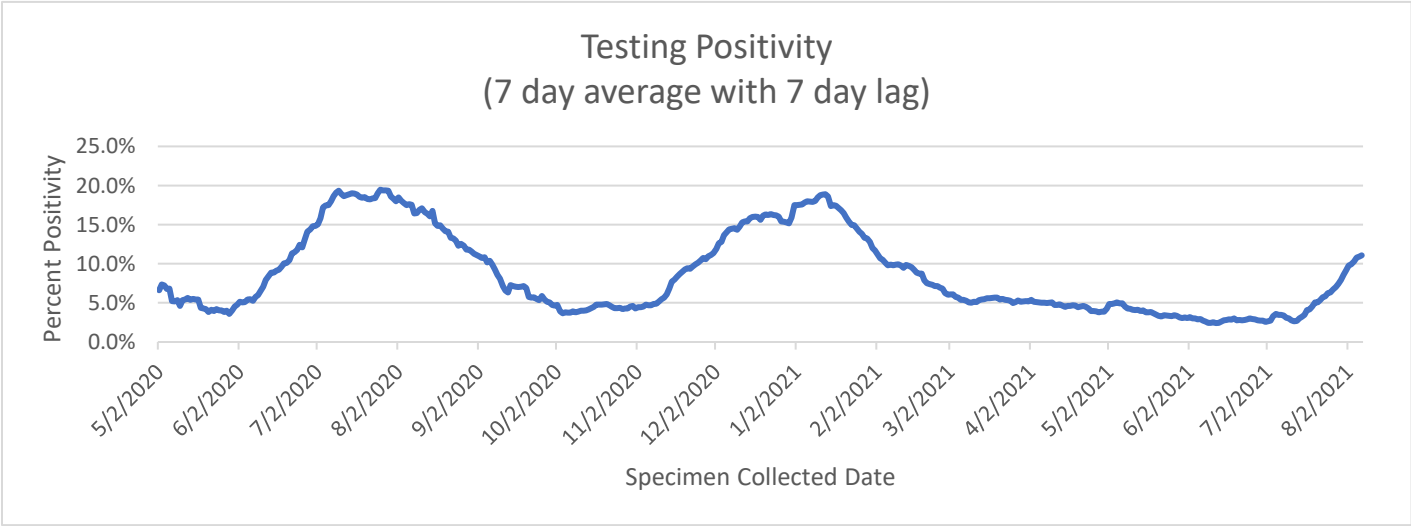

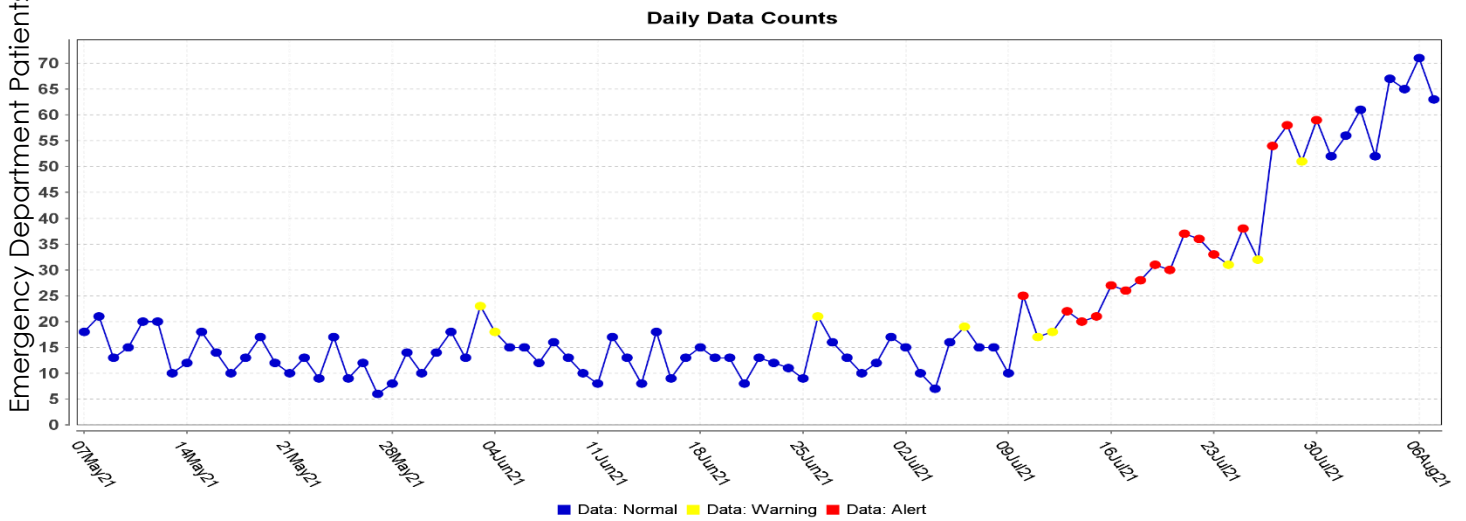


The graph below shows testing positivity (percent of tests that are positive), 7-day average with 7-day lag, through the report week. This may vary from state measures.



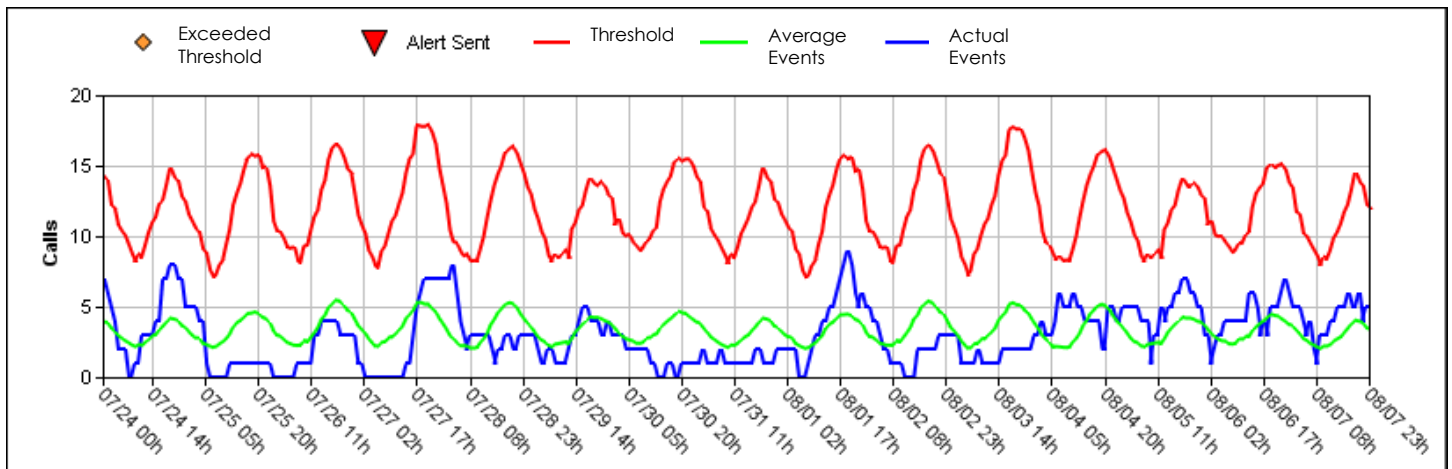
COMMUNITY MONITORING – EMERGENCY CASES COVID-19 LIKE ILLNESS
