SURVEILLANCE REPORT: August 22 – September 4, 2021



- The number of deaths due to COVID-19 have increased slightly in this two-week period.





This graph shows the daily number of COVID-19 confirmed cases reported among Stanislaus County residents by episode date.








The graph below shows testing positivity (percent of tests that are positive), 7-day average with 7-day lag, through the report week. This may vary from state measures.
